- Classifications of fire and fire extinguishment methods
- Fire extinguisher classification and rating systems
- Hands-on training - using fire extinguishers the right way
- Safety procedures when using a portable fire extinguishers

Booking a Seminar

Facility Requirements

An appropriate area to conduct the theory component, with adequate seating to accommodate the class size, a TV, VCR, access to a power supply and an outdoor location to conduct the hands-on component.

Seminar Cost and Class Size

A flat rate of \$250.00 per class. Time only permits one morning and one afternoon session per day with a **class size of not more than 25 persons**.

Fire Extinguishers

Facilities will be required to provide the necessary portable fire extinguishers. We recommend the following for a class of 25 persons:

- 10 dry chemical extinguishers (3A-10BC)
- 5 Carbon Dioxide extinguishers (5 lbs)
- 2 water extinguishers
