

"If we can't find you..
..*we can't help you.*"



Have you ever heard the saying "time saves lives?" That saying refers to the fact that in a fire, medical or police emergency, the quicker emergency responders get to you, the better your chance of survival! When emergency professionals are responding to your call for help... **we can't always find you quickly!**

When was the last time you checked the front of your house?

Make sure your address number is clearly visible from the street – day or night!

What can you do?

- C Make sure your address is clearly posted on your house and at the entrance of your driveway, if your house is set back from the roadway.
- C Keep bushes, plantings, and trees trimmed so as not to interfere with the view of your house number from the road.
- C Your address should be printed in large letters and numbers, on a contrasting color background, and be visible from at least 150 feet.
- C Illuminated house signs or reflective lawn signs are acceptable, or lights may be used to illuminate your house number.

The first few minutes of a fire or emergency are the most critical.
